Our museum is in the possession of a reconstructed Spitfire with the code 3W-S.

This aircraft is located in a hall opposite the Fort.

In 2003 the Spitfire came to our museum and has been a centerpiece ever since, together with the exhibitions about the air war. Visitors can visit this legendary aircraft in our Spitfire hall.
